This apprenticeship framework deals with the repair and maintenance of all types of light vehicles. Apprentices may work for a dealership and focus on a particular manufacturer, or work for an independent garage that deals with many different makes of vehicles. Level 2 apprentices will work in a service technician role, carrying out routine maintenance and basic repairs, as well as identifying and reporting faults. Level 3 apprentices will learn about more complex faults and how to identify and repair them; with the opportunity to take some responsibility for the workshop and other team members.

Delivery model and duration:

Level 2 – delivered in the workplace with 1 day per week in college
Level 3 – delivered in the workplace, with 1 day per week in college in the first year and entirely in the workplace during the second year

Duration: Level 2 - 24 months, Level 3 - 24 months
