You'll learn: drawing, fine art, painting and elements of sculpture and surface design, graphic design and illustration, photography, printmaking and contextual studies.

Expect to: develop a great and broad portfolio of work that can support your application to a higher education course, to start your own business or enter employment.

You'll love: dedicated studio space five days a week to work on projects and live assignment briefs. As well as our iMac suites and close links with artists in the industry.

This course covers a broad range of topics relevant to the art and design industry.

This is a level 3 course in art and design that covers a wide range of topics including:

- Visual recording
- Historical and contextual studies
- Materials, techniques and processes
- Ideas and concepts
- Visual communication.

Areas covered may include illustration, 3D design, painting, printmaking, fashion/textiles, photography and sculpture depending upon campus and learners. Gloucestershire College has excellent facilities, and specialised staff with industry experience. You will take part in live assignment briefs and have the chance to be part of a variety of trips.

The College has close links with artists, for example PJ Crook (our honorary Vice President) and Russell Haines and many of our lecturers are also artists within their own right. We forge close links with industry including local galleries and exhibition space for students to show their work. You will enjoy large, light working spaces, a dedicated fashion room at our Cheltenham Campus, print room, darkroom, life drawing studio, photography studio and digital art suites (both Mac and PC).

Entry Requirements

A minimum of four GCSEs at grades A*-C or 4 and above, including both maths and English. Or a minimum
