Students will study theory and practical applications of the following:

- Provide manicure treatments
- Provide pedicure treatments
- Shaping and colouring eyebrows
- Apply make up
- Provide facial skincare
- Health and safety in the salon
- Salon reception duties
- Client care and communication in beauty related industries

Typical Entry Criteria Three GCSE subjects at Grade 3 and above: Gloucestershire College welcome any other/combinations of relevant qualifications that are comparable and/or equivalent to the typical course entry requirements.

Applicants that do not have recognised qualifications may still meet course entry requirements through alternative methods of assessment at the College's discretion.
